

First time Auditioning



Got a few questions?

First of all...Welcome and RELAX!

We realize that auditioning is a stressful part of the performing process. We here at CMT promise to do everything we can to make it an enjoyable experience for you.

***Singing Audition**-You will be asked to stand up in front of the Director and Musical Director and sing a song. Hopefully you have prepared one ahead of time and brought music with you, if not, we have some songs that you can choose from (check with the information table for available songs). This is an opportunity for the directing staff to hear what your voice sounds like and how loud or soft you sing. After singing, you will be asked to read a scene from the show. Read with as much character as you can. Advice: Look directly at the director and smile. Sing with strong volume and have confidence in yourself.

***Movement Audition**-You will be taken in a group to learn a short movement/dance audition with the choreographer (dance teacher). This is an opportunity for us to see how well you move/dance. Often times in a musical, you will need to do some movement when you are singing. The choreographer is the person that puts the movement together and teaches it to you. Advice: Always smile when dancing. You should not look like you are in pain. Have fun and keep your head up, don't look at the floor.
